Quest of Life Media & Broadcast will be a non-profit organization.

The initial structure of QoLMB will be the Umbrella organization (QoLMB) with the subsidiaries Wild Planet Radio (WPR) and Not Weird, Queer Radio Show (NWQ).

Quest of Life Media & Broadcast will raise funds, distribute grants, partner with organizations, and over see non-profit administration.

-Staffing will be Executive Director, and 3 paid support staff.

Wild Planet Radio will be the in house internet radio, maintaining independent operations and providing partnering artists a venue through which their music can be distributed to and heard by a larger audience.

-Staffing will be Station Director utilizing paid support staff and admin of QoLMB.

Not Weird, Queer will continue to be an independent production geared to highlighting the music of independent LGBT artists providing content to WPR and other organizations.

-No paid staffing. It will continue to be the voluntary project of Steve Sims and utilizing as need paid support staff and admin of QoLMB.
